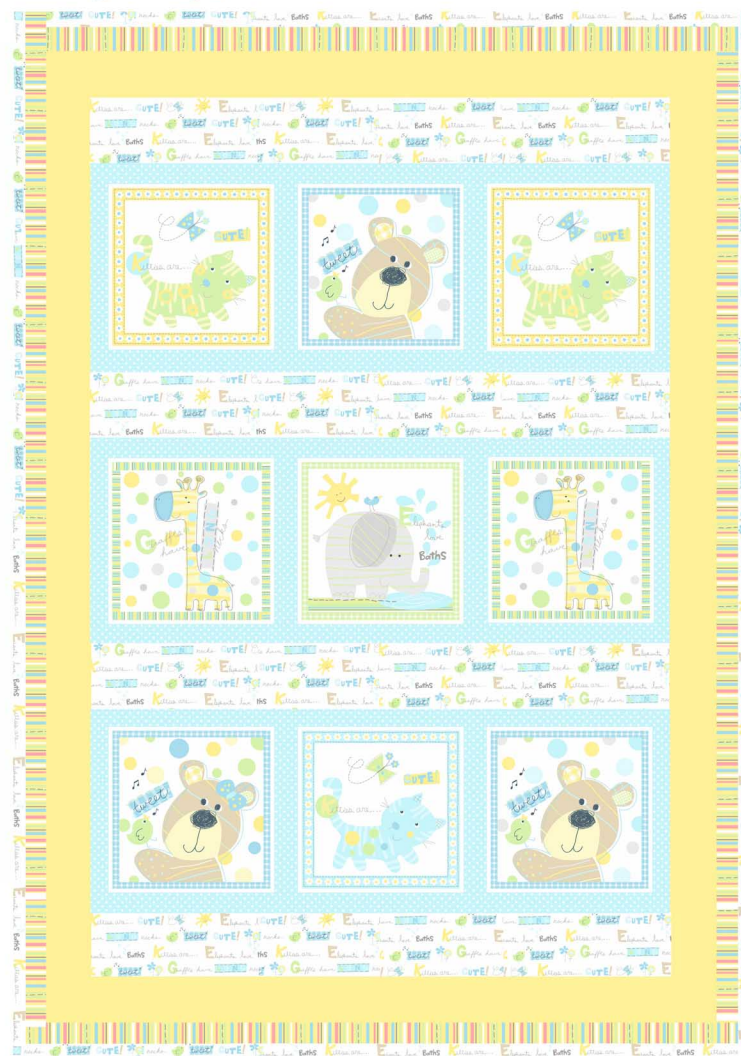

FABRIC YARDAGE CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Panel print (3rows of animals) (SKU 30380)	1 yd	(3) horizontal rows of animals with 1" of dot showing on top and bottom, left and right sides of strip.
White w/words (SKU 30379)	7/8 yd	(4) 3-1/2" x 36" strips, (5) 2-1/4" x WOF binding
Yellow stripe (SKU 30376-3)	1/3 yd	(6) 1-1/2" x WOF
Yellow chamois / fleece*	2 yd	(2) 4-1/2" x 48" strips, (2) 4-1/2" x 44" strips

The rest is for the backing

* Chamois or fleece can also be replaced by Yellow check SKU 30375 -3

PANEL CENTER

1.) Sew the white/words strips to the top and bottom of a panel row. Repeat to make another set.



2.) Sew sets to top and bottom of third panel to complete quilt center.



BORDERS:

Add (2) 4-1/2" x 48" yellow chamois strips to right and left sides. Sew (2) 4-1/2" x 44" yellow chamois strips to top and bottom.

Cut two 1-1/2" x width of fabric yellow stripe strips in half and add to each of remaining (4) strips. Sew strips to right and left sides of quilt. Trim edges. Sew to top and bottom of quilt to complete border. Trim.

FINISH:

Sandwich quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Sew binding on and hand stitch.
