Loves Me Loves Me Not

- 6. Sew the fabric B vertical borders to sides of the quilt center and the fabric B horizontal borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
- 7. Sew the fabric Q vertical borders to sides of the quilt center and the fabric Q horizontal borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
- 8. Sew the fabric E vertical borders to sides of the quilt center and the fabric E horizontal borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
- 9. Referring to the quilt photo sew the 3-1/2" x 5-1/2" border rectangles together into (2) strips with (13) rectangles in the top and bottom borders and (15) border rectangles in the vertical borders.
- 10. Fold each of the (34) fabric O circles in half with right sides together. Press fold lines. Sew around the curved edge of the resulting half circle. Using your rotary cutter and ruler, trim along the fold line to open the circles and turn them right side out. Press the curved line of the half circle. This makes the individual scallops for the borders, For the side borders arrange (8) scallops along the top and bottom edges of the quilt and (9) scallops along the opposite sides of the quilt. Line up the raw edges of the scallops even with the raw edges of the right side of the quilt top with the curved edges facing in towards the quilt center. Machine baste in place a scant 1/4" from the outside edge. Fold scallops OUT with seam allowances facing in towards the center on the wrong side of the quilt top. Press firmly in place.

Quilting

- 11. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Baste the layers together, As you quilt the layers together STOP quilting 3/8" to 1/2" from outside edge. Do not catch the scalloped edge of the quilt in with your quilting stitches.
- 12. Trim the excess batting first, keeping it even with the folded edge of the quilt top. Trim the backing fabric 1/4" beyond the folded edge of the quilt top so you can turn it in towards the center of the quilt and stitch in place to finish the out side edge of the quilt.

Backing: 3-1/4 yds 30366-2 green. Cut and fit to make a 54" x 60" backing piece

Sewing

- 1. Following the manufacturer's directions, fuse then applique the flower to the background rectangle.
- 2. Sew the fabric Q vertical borders to sides of the center applique panel and the fabric O horizontal borders to the top and bottom of the applique rectangle.
- 3. Refer carefully to the color photo of the quilt for placement of fabrics when sewing the following strips together. Using fabric R and fabric T 2-1/2" squares sew in strips as follows: (4) strips with (6) fabric R and (5) fabric T squares and (4) strips with (5) fabric R and (6) fabric T squares.
- 4. Sew (4) strips (2 in each R-T combination) together checkerboard style. Sew this unit to the left side of the center applique panel.
- 5. Using the remaining 4 checkerboard strips, sew 1 strip from each set together to make a double strip with fabric T and R squares making a checkerboard pattern. Make 2 units. Sew a fabric B 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle to one end of each of these strips, then sew one unit to the top and one unit to the bottom of the center quilt assembly.
