## 3. Pieced Border

### Corner Blocks



Diagram 1

Refer to Diagram 1.

Sew (1) corner block using  
(1) 4 3/4" square of #29670-2  
Large brown mushroom print  
and (4) triangles of #29675-2  
Brown dots.

Repeat to make (4) corner blocks.  
Press and trim each block to  
6 1/2" X 6 1/2".

### Pieced Blocks

Following above procedure, make each block by sewing (1) 4 3/4" block of miscellaneous fabric to (4) triangles cut from a different miscellaneous fabric.

Repeat to make (16) blocks.

Press and trim each block to 6 1/2" X 6 1/2".

Sew pieced blocks together into (4) rows of (4) blocks each.

Sew (1) row of pieced blocks to each side of quilt top.

Sew a corner block to each end of the remaining rows of blocks.

Sew (1) row of (4) pieced blocks and (2) corner blocks to the top of quilt top.

Sew (1) row of (4) pieced blocks and (2) corner blocks to the bottom of quilt top.

Quilt top should now measure 36 1/2" X 36 1/2".

# Merry Mushrooms

Block Size: 6" finished

Number of Blocks: 20

## Fabric Requirements:

- 1 yard #29675-2 Brown dots for background center, background of corner squares
- 1/4 yard #29670-1 Large orange mushroom print for large mushroom top appliqué motif
- 5/8 yard #29676-4 Orange print for borders
- 1/4 yard #29670-2 Large brown mushroom print for centers of corner squares
- 1/4 yard each of #30266-8, #29671-5, #29674-8, #29671-4 Miscellaneous prints for center squares in pieced border
- 1/8 yard #29675-1, #29675-5, #29674-1, #29675-7, #29677-2, #30266-4 Miscellaneous prints for center appliqué motifs and backgrounds for pieced blocks

## Cutting Directions:

- #29675-2 Brown dots
- Cut (1) 21 1/2" X 21 1/2" square for center appliqué.
- Cut (1) 4" strip across width of fabric. Cut (8) 4" X 4" squares.
- Cut each square once diagonally to make (16) triangles for background of outside squares of pieced border.
- #29670-1 Large orange mushroom print
- Cut large mushroom top motif for center appliqué.

#29676-4 Orange print

Cut (8) 2 1/2" strips across width of fabric.

Cut (2) 2 1/2" X 20 1/2" and (2) 2 1/2" X 24 1/2" strips for inner border.

Cut (2) 2 1/2" X 36 1/2" and (2) 2 1/2" X 40 1/2" strips for outer border.

#29670-2 Large brown mushroom print

Cut (4) 4 3/4" X 4 3/4" squares for centers of corner squares in pieced border.

From all fabrics:

Cut (16) 4 3/4" X 4 3/4" squares for centers of pieced blocks.

For each background of a block in the pieced border, cut (2) 4" X 4" squares.

Cut each square once diagonally to make (4) triangles for each block.

Repeat to make (4) triangles for each of the (16) pieced blocks.

Cut motifs for appliqué center -- if preparing for needleturn, add seam allowance.

## Instructions:

### 1. Appliqué Center

Arrange motifs on 21 1/2" X 21 1/2" square of #29675-2 Brown dots. Fasten motifs to fabric, using appliqué technique of choice.

Press and trim fabric square to 20 1/2" X 20 1/2".

### 2. Inner Border

Sew (1) 2 1/2" X 20 1/2" strip of #29676-4 Orange print to each side of center.

Sew (1) 2 1/2" X 24 1/2" strip of #29676-4 Orange print to top of appliqué center.

Sew (1) 2 1/2" X 24 1/2" strip of #29676-4 Orange print to bottom of appliqué center.

Press. Quilt top should now measure 24 1/2" X 24 1/2".

## 4. Outer Border

Sew (1) 2 1/2" X 36 1/2" strip of #29676-4 Orange print to each side of center.

Sew (1) 2 1/2" X 40 1/2" strip of #29676-4 Orange print to top of appliquéd center.

Sew (1) 2 1/2" X 40 1/2" strip of #29676-4 Orange print to bottom of appliquéd center.

Press. Quilt top should now measure 40 1/2" x 40 1/2".

Quilt and bind, as desired.

Increase 400% to make proper size for a 20 1/2" X 20 1/2" finished size block.
