Repeat three more times.




Assemble two Fabric K rectangles and one Fabric J/A Unit as shown.




Assemble one Fabric F/I/F Unit and one Fabric G/F/H Unit as shown.




Quilt Assembly:

Attach side inner borders using Fabric D strips. Attach top and bottom inner borders using Fabric E strips.




