1. Cut 12 background squares 17.5 inches x 17.5 inches in the amounts shown below.

2. Using the template on pages 4 and 5 (cut the two pieces out and tape together to create the complete plane shape) cut out 12 planes in the following fabrics in amounts shown. Also cut 12 plane shapes out of lightweight fusible webbing.

3. From 29003 Black solid,

For sashing:

Cut (8) 2.5 inch x WOF strips.

Sub-cut above into: (8) 2.5 x 17.5 inch rectangles

Sew remaining 2.5 inch strips into (3) 2.5 x 59 inch strips.

For inner border:

Cut (7) 1.5 inch x WOF strips. Seam and trim into:

(2) 1.5 x 59 inch strips and (2) 1.5 x 77 inch strips.

For binding:

Cut (7) strips 2.25 inches x WOF.

4. From both 37275-4 Orange and lightweight fusible webbing:

Using the template on page 6, cut out 6 circles.


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
Using the template on page 7, cut out 10 half-circles.

Using the template on page 7, cut out 4 quarter-circles.

5. From 37275-4 Orange, cut (7) 3 inch x WOF strips. Sew these strips into (2) 3 x 63.5 inch strips and (2) 3 x 81.5 inch strips.

6. From 37275-1 Blue cut (7) strips 1.5 inches x WOF. Sew into (2) 1.5 x 66 inch strips and (2) 1.5 x 84 inch strips for border.










#### Sewing instructions:

- 1. Iron fusible onto each plane shape, following manufacturers instructions and peel off backing. Then, following the photograph on the cover, match each plane with the appropriate background fabric. Pay attention to the direction of the plane (some of them turn!) and the direction of the background fabric. Once you have ironed the planes on, sew around the edge of each shape with your favorite machine applique stitch.
- 2. Sew the prepared background fabrics together with the 2.5 x 17.5 inch black rectangles to create four rows of three blocks each with black sashing in between.
- 3. Using the 2.5 x 59 inch black strips in between each row, sew the four rows together.
- 4. Using the 1.5 inch black border strips, sew black border around all four sides of quilt beginning with the 1.5 x 59 inch strips on the top and bottom.
- 5. Iron fusible onto each circle, half-circle and quarter-circle, following manufacturer's instructions and peel off backing. Apply the shapes to corners of the blocks using your iron and following the layout on the cover. Sew around the raw edges of the shapes with your favorite machine applique stitch.
- 6. Using the orange camouflage border strips, sew the second inner border to the quilt, beginning with the top and bottom strips.
- 7. Using the blue camouflage border strips, sew the outer border to the quilt, beginning with the top and bottom strips.
- 8. Quilt and bind using your favorite method.
