# Rhumba

Backing: 4 yds fabric D, cut in half for (2) 2 yd pieces and sew together selvedge to sevledge for backing.

Binding: 2/3 yd fabric A, cut into 2-1/4" strips and sew together end-to-end for binding.

### **Sewing:**

- 1. Nine Patch blocks: refer to the color image of the quilt and sew together (10) Nine Patch blocks mixing and matching the 3-1/2" squares.
- 2. Triple Rail Blocks: Refer to the color image of the qult and sew together (12) Triple Rail blocks using the 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" pieces.
- 3. Refer to the color image of the quilt and arrange the (10) 9-1/2" squares, the (10) Nine Patch blocks and the (8) Triple Rail blocks as shown.
- 4. Referring to the color image of the quilt arrange and sew the  $45^{\circ}$  angle pieces and the fabric H triangles into larger setting triangles for the outside edges of the quilt. Place them in the arrangement with the blocks you arranged in Step 3.
- 5. Sew the blocks, squares and setting triangles together in diagonal rows to complete the center area of the quilt.
- 6. Sew the fabric C vertical borders to the sides of the quilt top and the fabric C horizontal borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 7. Center and sew the fabric E vertical borders to opposite sides of the quilt top. Center and sew the fabric E horizontal borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Miter the corners and trim away excess fabric.

### Finishing:

- 8. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Baste, then quilt the layers together.
- 9. Fold the binding lengthwise and sew to quilt top. Turn binding to back of quilt and stitch in place.

### **Fabric Requirements:**

Fabric A	1/3 yd 30125-3 brown
Fabric B	2/3 yd 30126-4 green
Fabric C	1 yd 30127-5 brown
Fabric D	1/2 yd 30128-6 pink
Fabric E	1-3/4 yd 30129-5 pink
Fabric F	1/3 yd 30134-4 green
Fabric G	1/4 yd 30130-5 pink
Fabric H	1 yd 30131-5 brown
Fabric I	1/3 yd 30132-4 green
Fabric J	1/4 yd 30132-5 pink
Fabric K	1/3 yd 30132-6 orange

## **Cutting:**

\*In cutting wof denotes width of fabric.

Fabric A (1) 9-1/2" x wof srip, recut into (3) 9-1/2" squares

Fabric B (1) 9-1/2" x wof strip, recut into (3) 9-1/2" squares and

(1) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip.

(2) 3-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (16) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" squares.

### From remainder cut

(1) 3-1/2" x 6-5/8" strip; then fold this strip in half lengthwise and cut from the fold line towards the raw edge at a 45° angle to create the pointed end of the strip.

Fabric C (6) 2-1/2" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end then cut (2) 2-1/2" x 66-1/4" vertical borders and (2) 2-12" x 55-1/2" horizontal borders.

- (1) 9-1/2" x wof strip, recut into (2) 9-1/2" squares and
- (1) 3-1/2" x wof strip, recut (8) 3-1/2" squares

- Fabric D (1) 9-1/2" x wof strip, recut into (2) 9-1/2" squares, recut remainder of strip into (2) 3-1/2" x wof strips. Cut these strips into (8) 3-1/2" squares.
  - (1) 3-1/2" x wof strip, recut into (1) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip and
  - (2) 3-1/2" x 6-7/8" strips; trim these two strips from the bottom left corner at a  $45^{\circ}$  angle to the top of the strip.
- Fabric E (8) 6-1/2" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end, matching stripes if possible, then recut into (2) 81" vertical borders and (2) 68-1/4" horizontal borders
- Fabric F (3) 3-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (14) 3-1/2" squares; cut remainder into (2) 3-1/2" x 6-7/8" strips trimming one strip at a 45° angle from bottom left towards top and the other in the opposite direction. Cut remainder into (1) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip. Cut an additional 3-1/2" square, then cut in half on diagonal for (1) corner triangle.
- Fabric G (2) 3-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (15) 3-1/2" squares. Cut remainder into (1) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip
- Fabric H (2) 9-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (24) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips.

  (4) 3-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (14) 3-1/2" x 9-7/8" pieces, then cut (7) strips from lower left corner at a 45° angle from lower left to top of strip. Cut (7) strips from lower right at a 45 to top of strip. Cut remainder of the 2nd 3-1/2" strip into (2) strips 3-1/2" x 10-1/4" then cut from lower edge on both ends at a 45° angle in towards the top of each strip.
  - (1) 3-7/8" x width of fabric strip, recut into (9) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half on diagonal once to make a total of (18) triangles.
- Fabric I (3) 3-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (3) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips; (3) 3-1/2" x 6-7/8" strips recutting (2) at a 45° angle from lower left corner towards top and (2) from lower right towards top of strip. Cut remainder into (8) 3-1/2" squares. Cut (1) 3-1/2" square, then cut in half on diagonal for a triangle.
- Fabric J (2) 3-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (1) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip; (10) 3-1/2" squares and (4) 3-1/2" x 6-7/8" strips. Recut (3) 6-7/8" strips from bottom left at a 45° angle and (1) strip from bottom right at a 45° angle.
- Fabric K (3) 3-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (3) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips; (9) 3-1/2" squares and (3) 3-1/2" x 6-7/8" strips. Recut (1) 6-7/8" strip from bottom left at a 45° angle and (2) strips from bottom right at a 45° angle. Cut (1) 3-1/2" x 6-5/8" strip; then fold this strip in half lengthwise and cut from the fold line towards the raw edge at a 45° angle to make a point on end of the strip.
