


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Fabric Requirements

- 37514-8 Aqua 3/8 yard
- 37511-8 Aqua 3/8 yard
- 37514-7 Yellow 3/8 yard
- 37512-7 Yellow 3/8 yard
- 37514-1 Green 1/4 yard
- 37512-1 Green 1/4 yard
- 37514-2 Red 1/4 yard
- 37511-2 Red 1/4 yard
- 37515-6 Coral 1/8 yard
- 37512-6 Coral 1/8 yard
- 37514-5 Purple 1/8 yard
- 37511-5 Purple 1/8 yard
- 34033-11 White 2 7/8 yards

Cutting Instructions

- 4 @ 2.5" x WOF strips Sub-cut 1 @ 6.5" piece
- 4 @ 2.5" x WOF strips Sub-cut 1 @ 6.5" piece
- 5 @ 2.5" x WOF strips Sub-cut 1 @ 6.5" piece
- 5 @ 2.5" x WOF strips Sub-cut 1 @ 6.5" piece
- 3 @ 2.5" x WOF strips Sub-cut 1 @ 6.5" piece
- 3 @ 2.5" x WOF strips Sub-cut 1 @ 6.5" piece
- 3 @ 2.5" x WOF strips
- 3 @ 2.5" x WOF strips
- 1 @ 2.5" x WOF strips Sub-cut 1 @ 6.5" piece
- 1 @ 2.5" x WOF strips Sub-cut 1 @ 6.5" piece
- 1 @ 2.5" x WOF strips Sub-cut 1 @ 6.5" piece
- 1 @ 2.5" x 22.5" strips Sub-cut 1 @ 6.5" piece
- 34 @ 2.5" x WOF strips
- 6 @ 4.5 x WOF strips for border



Piecing instructions

1. Taking the sub-cut 6.5×2.5 inch rectangles. Sew the lighter and darker of each color together, like so:



After sewing these rectangles, set aside.

2. Organize your long strips into piles of one dark strip, one light strip and one white strip, like so:



- 3. Sew these three strips together in this order: dark color, light color, white. Press seams toward the darker color.
- 4. Now, sub-cut across the 3 strips, 6.5 inch squares in the quantities indicated below (your three strips sewn together should measure 6.5 inches).

Quantities: Yellow: 29, 3 strip squares

Aqua: 22 Red: 16 Green: 14 Coral: 5 Purple: 2

Set aside.


5. From the remaining three-strip sets, cut 1 each, 4.5" rectangle across the three strips, like so:



You should have 1 yellow, 1 turquiose, 1 green, 1 coral and 1 purple. Set aside with the pieces from step 1.



6. Assemble quilt rows following diagram below (**note black background is just a visual aid). You will just alternate the orientation of the 6.5 x 6.5 " blocks, until the last block on the right end, where you will place either a rectangle from step 1 or step 5, as indicated on image.



- 7. Sew top five rows together, then sew bottom 6 rows together. Sew two halves together to assemble quilt top.
- 8. Piece and sew on white border.
- 9. Quilt and bind as desired. **Note: I made a multi-color binding out of left-over strips.
