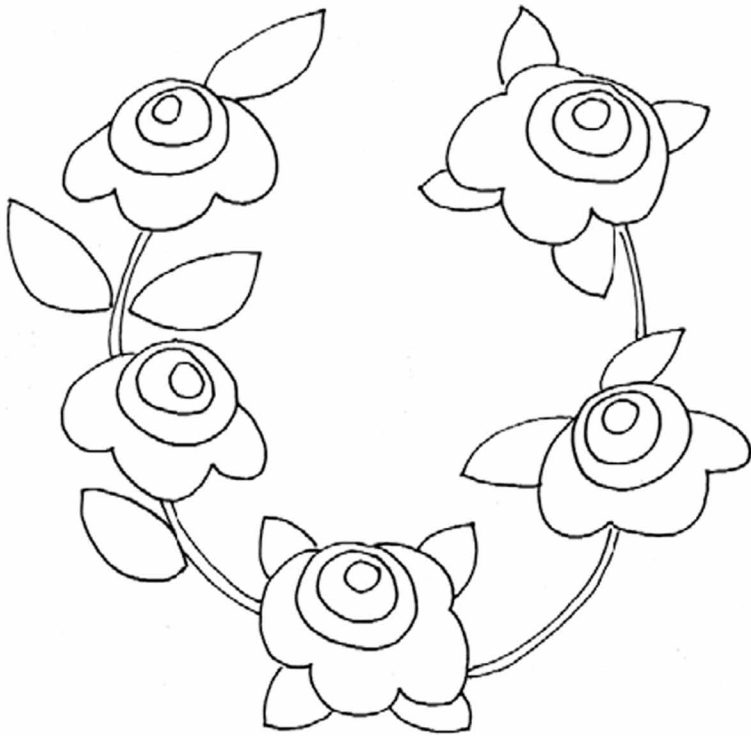


# Scarborough Place

Layer quilt top, batting and backing.  
Quilt using the floral ring pattern provided for 10" cream blocks,  
use applique floral patterns to quilt within the borders and  
quilt in the scappy block as desired to finish. Bind.

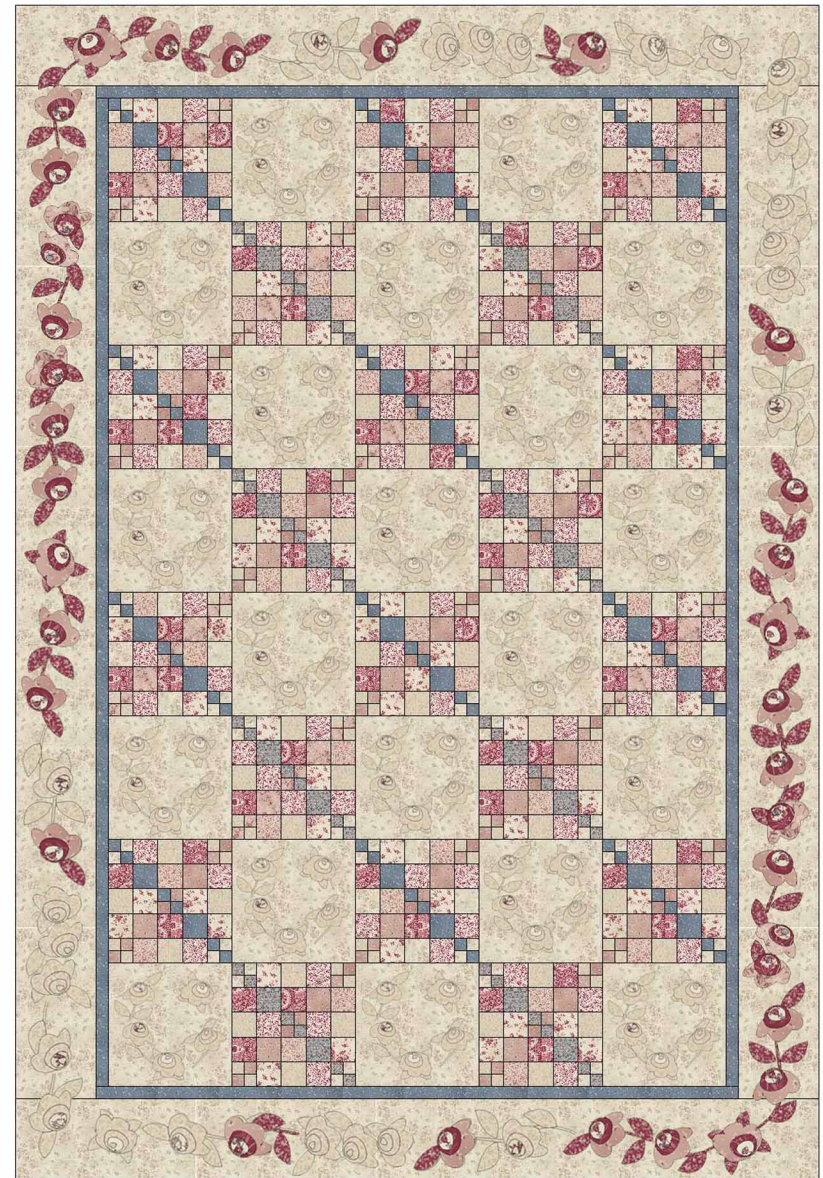

Quilt size: 64" x 94"

FABRIC	YARDAGE	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
(A) 30191-2 pink w/sprigs	1/2 yd	(24) 2-1/2"sq, (48) 1-1/2"sq (4) petals G, (12) petals H, (10) petals J
(B) 30257-2 pink vine floral	1/2 yd*	(16) 2-1/2"sq, (32) 1-1/2"sq (2) petals H, (4) petals J
(C) 30190-6 blue w/brwn/tan	1/3 yd	(16) 2-1/2"sq, (32) 1-1/2"sq (6) small center circles H1, J1
(D) 30191-4 blue	5/8 yd	(24) 2-1/2" sq, (48) 1-1/2"sq, (6) 1-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF)
(E) 30185-5 cream tonal floral	4-3/4 yds **	(2) 6-1/2" X 82-1/2", (2) 6-1/2" X 64-1/2" (80) 2-1/2" sq, (20) 10-1/2" sq, (10) 2-1/4" x WOF strips (binding)
(F) 30187-5 cream w/tonal vine	1/3 yd	(160) 1-1/2"sq

Cut a total of (240) 2-1/2" squares for the random placements.

(3) 2-1/2" x WOF of each print, sub-cut 2-1/2" will yield 240 total squares.

30185-1 cream w/red	1/3 yd
30186-5 cream/red flower	1/3 yd
30189-1 cream w/red spray	1/3 yd
30187-2 cream w/pk vine floral	1/3 yd
30257-2 pink w/ vine floral	1/3 yd*

\*Fabric listed in two places. You will need both yardage cuts listed.

Appliqué roses:

30188-1 red w/cream/pink vines	1/4 yd	(4) G3, (14) H3, (14) J3 large center circles (4) G1, (12) H1, (10) J1 small center circles
30185-3 cream w/brown vine	1/8 yd	(4) G2, (12) H2, (10) J2 middle center circle
30185-1 cream w/red vine	1/8 yd	(2) H2, (4) J2 middle center circle
30186-1 red w/cream floral	1/4 yd	(30-34) leaves and various stems
30187-1 red w/crm floral vine	1/4 yd	(30-34) leaves and various stems

Backing/Batting 5-1/2 yds

**SMALL 4-PATCH SQUARES:** (use the 1-1/2" squares of each print)



Blue outer corner squares:

Sew two blue 1-1/2" squares (C) to two 1-1/2" squares (F) alternately to create the small four-patch square. Make (16) of these sets. Repeat with fabrics D & F. Make (24) sets.

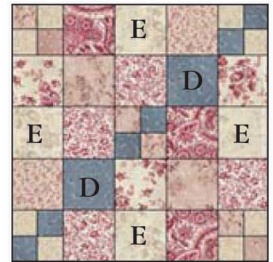
Center squares: fabrics D & B: make (6) sets, fabrics D & A: make (6) sets, fabrics C & B: make (3) sets, fabrics C & A: make (5) sets

Outer corner squares: fabrics A & F: make (24) sets, fabrics B & F: make (16) sets

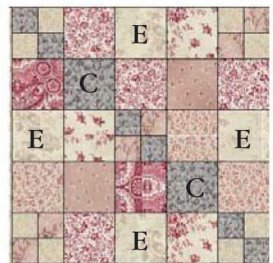
Referring to quilt picture, layout blocks with four-patch squares and the various 2-1/2 squares.

Notes about placement: The blocks are all basically the same with 12 blocks having a darker blue (D) diagonal and 8 blocks having a lighter blue (C) diagonal.

Place the various pink prints 2-1/2" squares randomly in each square. Place four-patch squares in the corners and center, matching blues to create a diagonal. Place cream (E) 2-1/2" squares in outer center of each side of the block as shown. Sew squares together in rows and then sew rows together to create the scrappy block.



Sew the large 10-1/2" (E) squares and the scrappy blocks together rotating diagonals as shown in quilt picture.



**BORDERS:**

Cut two 1-1/2" x width of fabric (D) strips in half and add to each of remaining (4) strips. Sew strips to right and left sides of quilt. Trim edges. Sew to top and bottom of quilt to complete border. Trim.

Add (2) 6-1/2" X 82-1/2" (E) strips to right and left sides.

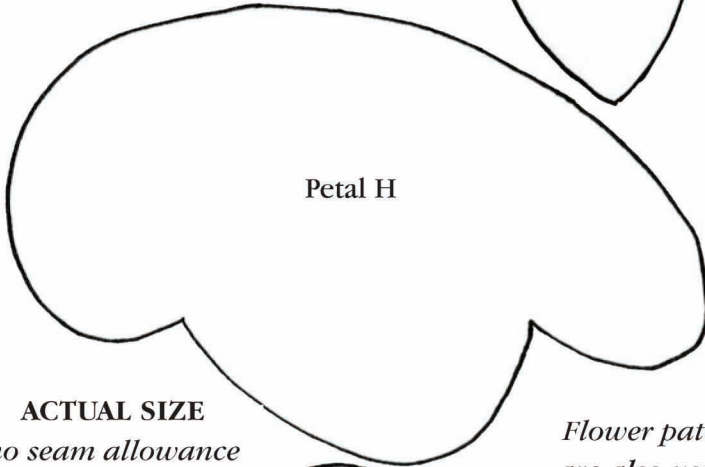
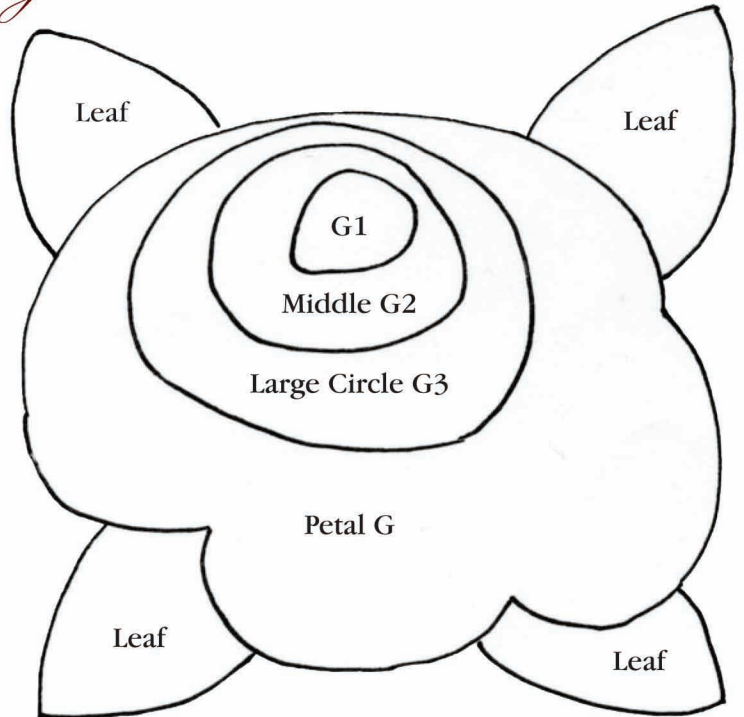
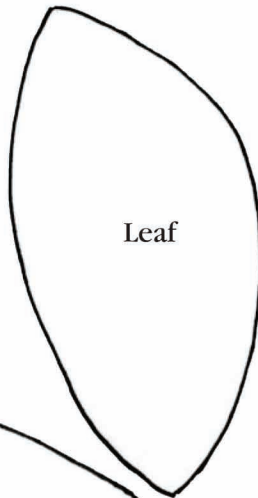
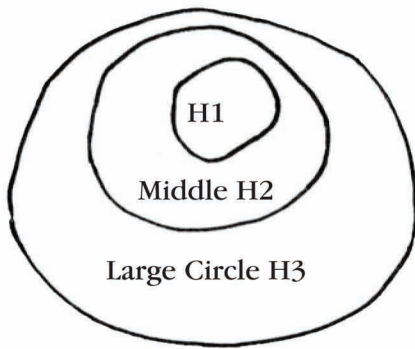
Sew (2) 6-1/2" X 64-1/2" (E) strips to top and bottom. Press.

**APPLIQUÉ**

Using a type of fusible webbing to adhere the appliqué pieces, place the roses and leaves to the two corners of the borders as shown in the quilt picture. Stitch around the appliqué to secure. (Leave some spaces for quilted flowers and leaves as shown in quilt picture)

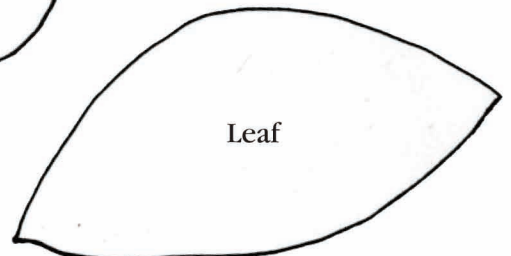
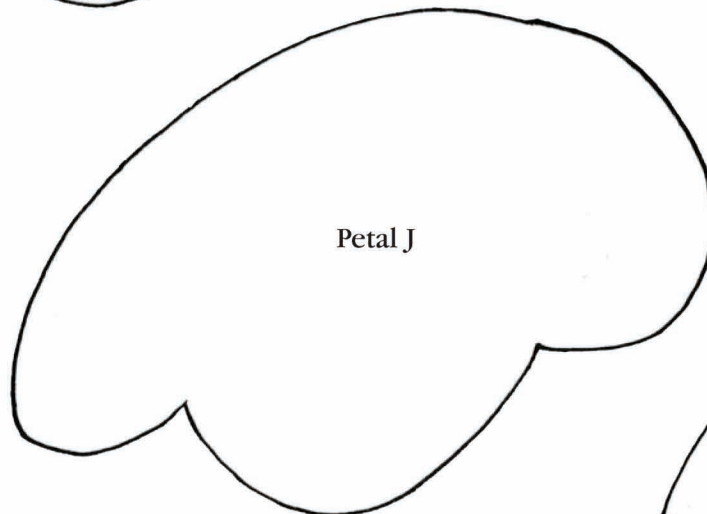
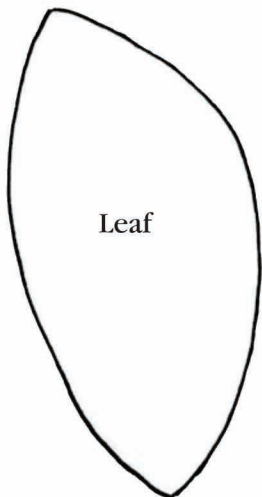
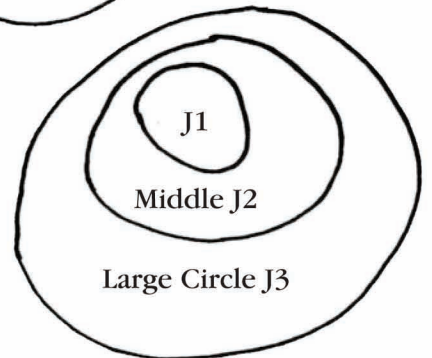
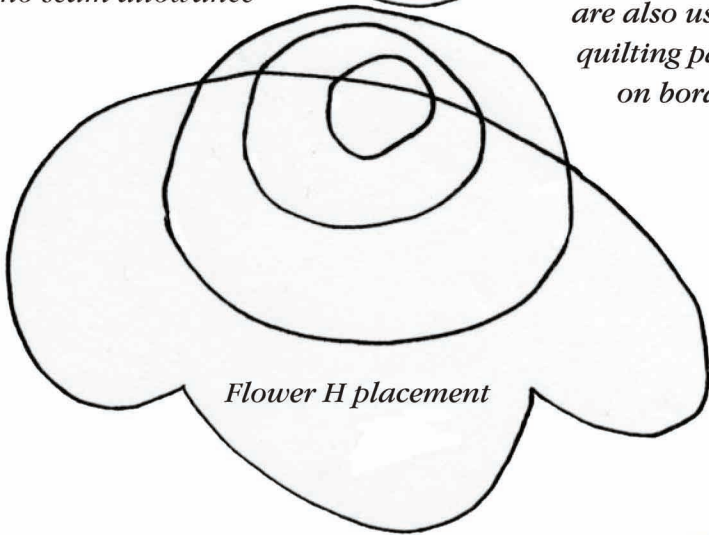
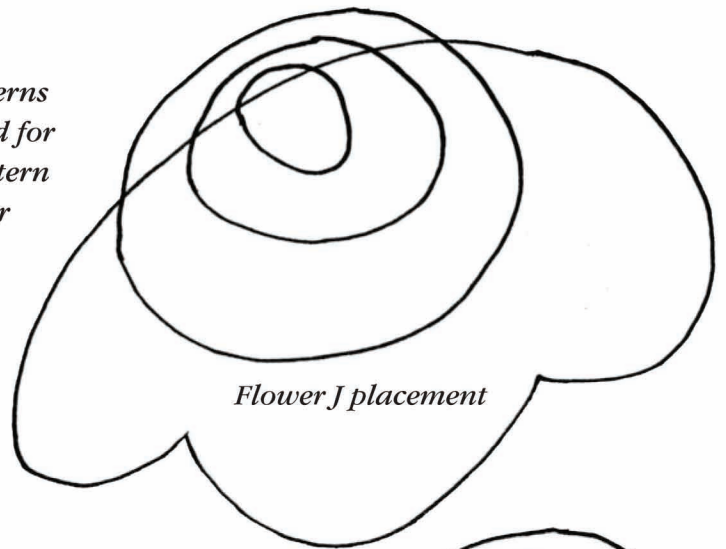
**Note:** Duplicate and turn left border and top border applique arrangement to make right border and bottom border arrangement.
